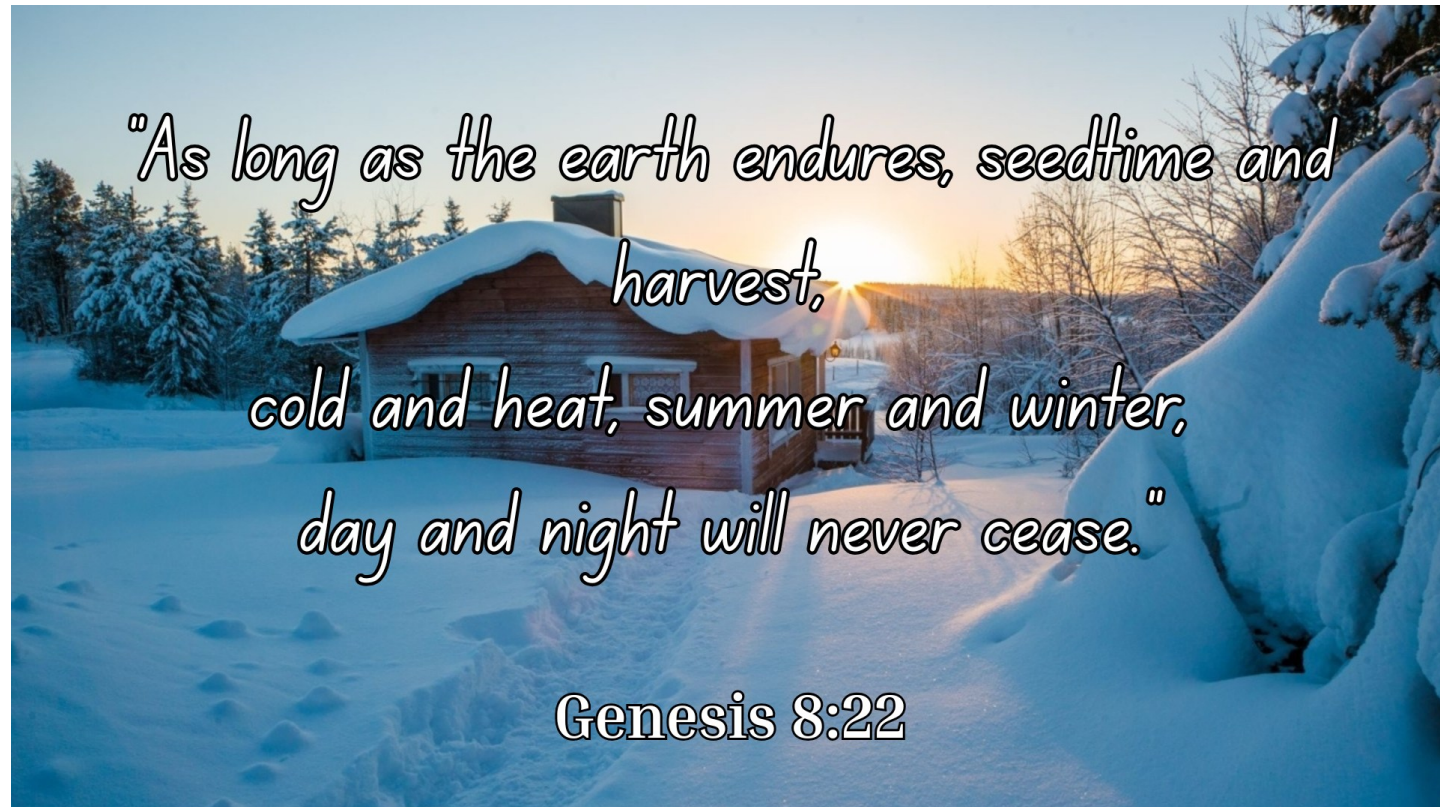

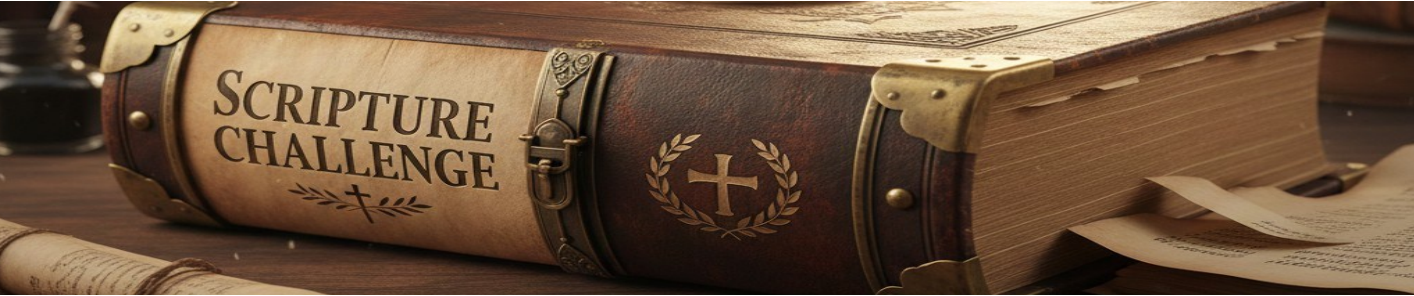

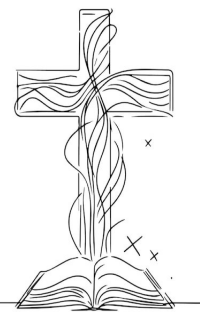


February Scripture Challenge

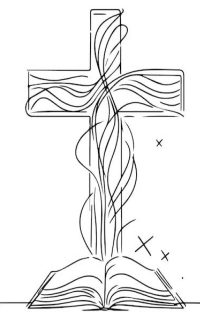
Dear Friends in Christ,

The scriptures will be divided into 5 sections:

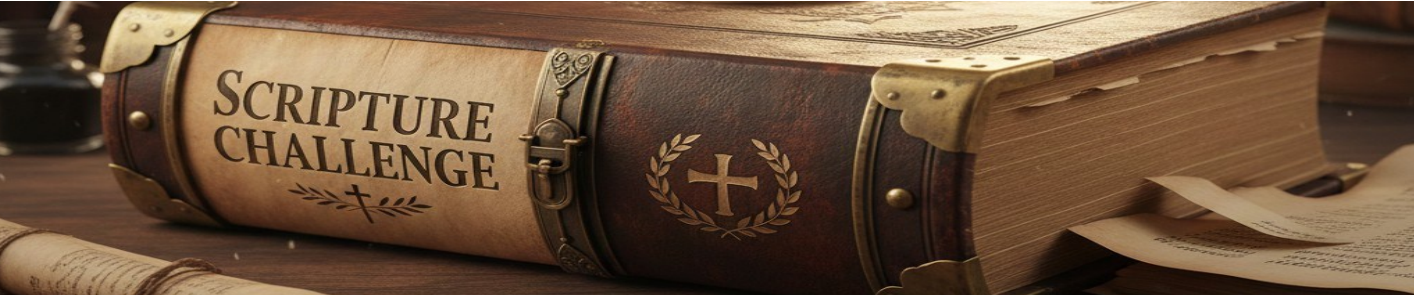


- 1. **God's Love for Us**
